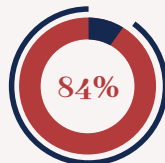

THE GREAT HEALTHCARE PLAN

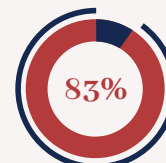

Americans are eager for Congressional action.

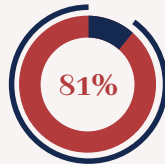
According to a national survey of 2,000 likely voters, conducted by McLaughlin & Associates, Americans support several proposals within the President's Great Healthcare Plan.



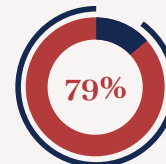
support requiring insurers to publicly disclose their revenue, overhead, and profit margins.

Our polling also found overwhelming bipartisan support for concrete solutions that deliver direct, tangible savings to patients:

88% Allowing manufacturers co-pay cards for seniors on Medicare

86% Expanding discounted cash-pay pricing through a government website

83% Implementing a flat out-of-pocket cap per prescription in Medicare, tiered by income

83% Allowing cash-pay credits count toward deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums
Example: Rep. Greg Murphy's (R-NC03) H.R. 8270: Every Dollar Counts Act

81% Supporting fair trade deals to end foreign freeloading on U.S. drug innovation
Example: Rep. Jodey Arrington's (R-TX19) H.R. 4780: USTRx Act
